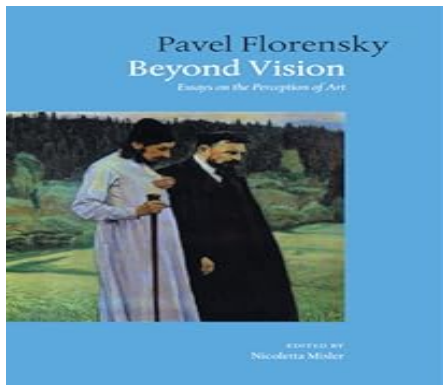


Kindle Beyond visions federal
